YOUNG MUSICIAN COMPETITION 2011 – 2012

The District 1070 Young Musician competition takes place annually. Entries must be submitted via Rotary Clubs, preferably following local heats.

The Competition is open to young people who permanently reside or attend schools within the District.

Following a local competition Rotary Clubs will submit one entry for each category to the District competition or if there are only a small number of candidates an adjudicator may individually audition each entrant.

CATEGORIES:

Solo Instrumental

Solo Vocal

Ensemble Instrumental (An ensemble is 2 - 4 players)

Ensemble Vocal, (2 - 4 singers)

Musical Groups, Choirs. (Groups and Choirs are 5 or more)

There is always much interest in this competition and our young people produce a high standard in the District. Instruments played include Vibraphone, Euphonium, Tenor Horn, Trumpet, Glockenspiels, Harp, Oboe, Soprano Saxophone and many more.

No recorded backing tapes are allowed in the District Competition, but they can be used for the local event.

AGE GROUPS:

Junior: Age 6 - 10 years, Intermediate: 11 - 13 years, Senior: 14 - 17 years

The age of each entrant on **31st August 2011** is the age for the purpose of entry to this event. When there is more than one person in an entry, then the age of the oldest person will decide which age category they will enter.

Key Dates:

All local competitions have to be completed before 10th February 2012

10th February 2012 all entries from clubs must be received by the District Organiser

25th February 2012 Northern and Eastern Semi Finals

26th February 2012 Southern Semi Final

11th March 2012 District Final

24th March 2012 Regional Final

13th April 2012 Rotary International in Great Britain and Ireland (RIBI) Final in Bournemouth
