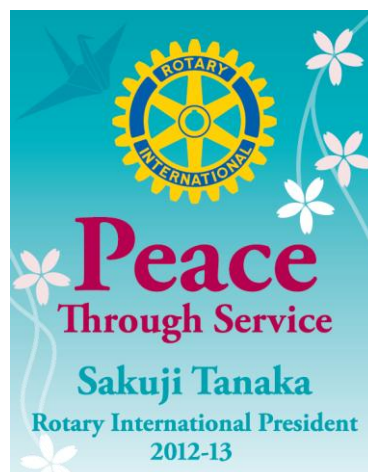

Meals and Meetings

The meeting is in the Kettering Park Hotel & Spa complex and the area that we are using is the Rutland Suite.

The Registration includes coffee on arrival, during any breaks and lunch.

Should delegates wish, the registration also includes soft drinks during the day and are available on a self service basis at the various refreshment points within the areas that we are using.

All facilities are self contained within this area.

There will be a pay bar for drinks at lunchtime and any wine that you require.

Route

The Hotel is situated on the southern side of the town of Kettering (Sat Navs: NN15 6XT) The best approach is from the A14 leaving via the A509, (junction 9) and if travelling from the west, take the 2nd exit on the roundabout on leaving the A14, the hotel is then on your right; if leaving the A14 from the East, take the 5th exit and the hotel is on your right.

There is ample parking within the hotel grounds.
